Vaccine for Children Program

The Vaccine for Children Program provides vaccines for all children from birth through 18 years of age who meet one of the following criteria:

Child who has no health insurance coverage

Child is American Indian or Alaskan Native

Child is enrolled in Medicaid

(Medicaid Greencard, Medicaid HMO (s), Medipass, and Medicaid as secondary health coverage)

Child is underinsured

Underinsured means the child has some type of health insurance, but the benefit plan does not include immunizations.

Child who has insurance that has a limit on preventative (well-child, immunizations) care-once the limit has been met

Those who do not qualify:

- Children whose health insurance covers the cost of vaccinations are not eligible for VFC Program benefits, **even when the plan has a high deductible or the deductible has not been met.**
- Insured children whose provider does not offer vaccinations. These children should be taken to a medical clinic that offers vaccinations.

These children will be turned away at immunization clinics and referred to their medical home.

If your child does not qualify, please visit your doctor's office for your child's immunizations.
