

Board of Supervisors Office, Carroll, Iowa

The Board of Supervisors of Carroll County, Iowa met in regular adjourned session in the Boardroom of the Courthouse, in Carroll, Iowa, the County seat of said County on Monday, July 27, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. Central Daylight Saving Time pursuant to law, the rules of said Board and to the adjournment with the following members present: Marty Danzer, Dan Nieland, Del McDermott, and Eugene Meiners. Mark Beardmore was absent.

Motion by Danzer, second by McDermott to approve the agenda with one addition: Approve plat in Section 19, Newton Township. On roll call, all present voted aye.

Motion by Nieland, second by Danzer to approve the minutes of the July 20, 2009 meeting as presented. On roll call, all present voted aye.

Motion by McDermott, second by Nieland to approve claims for payment. On roll call, all present voted aye.

Motion by Nieland, second by Danzer to set 9:30 a.m. on August 10, 2009, as the time and date for a public hearing for a construction permit application for a confinement feeding operation for Nissly and Nissly Site 1. On roll call, all present voted aye.

County Engineer reviewed a utility permit for Iowa Telecom on 240th Street, east of Halbur. Motion by Nieland, second by McDermott to approve the utility permit for Iowa Telecom. On roll call, all present voted aye.

Engineer reviewed three drains that are in need of repair. Drain 57 needs repairs in Section 10 of Grant Township. Drain 20 needs repairs in Section 20 of Grant Township. Drain 70 needs repairs in the City of Breda, near the Sauk Trail. Motion by Nieland, second by Danzer to approve the necessary repairs to Drains 20, 57 and 70. On roll call, all present voted aye. Engineer also talked about work done by B & W Control Specialists and said they will continue working on Drain 77 this fall.

Motion by Danzer, second by Nieland to approve a plat of survey for Lot 2, SE1/4, Section 19-82-34. On roll call, all present voted aye.

County Treasurer, Peg Weitzel, reviewed the annual report for FY08-09. She reported that there were parcels available after the June tax sale, the first time this has ever happened. Property taxes will be mailed this week and drainage bills are associated with tax statements. Weitzel also reported that she will serve as a legislative lobbyist for the Treasurers' Association in 2010. Motion by Danzer, second by McDermott to approve the Treasurer's General Ledger Annual Report for FY08-09. On roll call, all present voted aye.

Nieland reported on Region V Hazmat meeting.

McDermott reported on Farm Bureau dinner and alley paving meeting.

Meiners reported on CADC, New Opportunities and meeting with Lt. Governor Patty Judge.

Motion by Danzer, second by McDermott to adjourn at 9:57 a.m. On roll call, all present voted aye.
