

**Board of Supervisors Office, Carroll, Iowa**  
**Monday, March 22, 2010**

The Board of Supervisors of Carroll County, Iowa met in regular adjourned session in the Boardroom of the Courthouse, in Carroll, Iowa, the County seat of said County on Monday, March 22, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. Central Daylight Saving Time pursuant to law, the rules of said Board and to the adjournment with the following members present: Marty Danzer, Dan Nieland, Mark Beardmore, Sheryl Wegner and Eugene Meiners.

Motion by Danzer, second by Wegner to approve the agenda with one addition: tree trimming in the unincorporated villages of Mt. Carmel, Maple River and Roselle. On roll call, all voted aye.

Motion by Nieland, second by Beardmore to approve the minutes of the March 15, 2010 meeting as written. On roll call, all voted aye.

Ambulance Director, Bill Fish, informed the Board that interviews are being conducted for a full-time position in the department. Discussion was held concerning a pay scale for EMT-Basic personnel. Fish suggested paying 90% of paramedic pay for EMT-Basic and remaining at that rate until the individual passes the paramedic test.

Fish also discussed storm damage to the Christmas displays at Swan Lake.

Motion by Beardmore, second by Danzer to approve claims for payment as presented. On roll call, all voted aye.

Motion by Nieland, second by Wegner to approve a class "C" liquor permit and Sunday sales for the Roselle Tavern. On roll call, all voted aye.

Board reviewed manure management updates for Floyd Klocke in Section 32, Newton Township and Rodney Hinnners in Section 30, Arcadia Township.

Discussion was held concerning broken tree limbs hanging in the public rights-of-way in the unincorporated villages of Mt. Carmel, Maple River and Roselle, as a result of the January ice storms. Motion by Nieland, second by Danzer to authorize Emergency Management Coordinator, Sara Nielsen, to obtain bids for trimming branches hanging in the public rights-of-way in Mt. Carmel, Maple River and Roselle. On roll call, all voted aye.

Nieland reported on USDA inspection of the Courthouse.

Beardmore reported on CACCC, RSVP, Ambulance Board meeting, Coalition of Human Services meeting, Tyler Technologies update, and National County Awareness Month update.
