

Board of Supervisors Office, Carroll, Iowa

The Board of Supervisors of Carroll County, Iowa, met in regular adjourned session in the Boardroom of the Courthouse, in Carroll, Iowa, the County seat of said County on Monday, November 17, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. Central Standard Time pursuant to law, the rules of said Board and to the adjournment with all members present: Eugene Meiners, Dan Nieland, Neil Trobak, Del McDermott and Marty Danzer.

Motion by Nieland, second by Trobak to approve the agenda with one addition: approve CDBG request for payment. On roll call, all voted aye.

Motion by McDermott, second by Nieland to approve minutes of the November 10, 2008 meeting as presented. On roll call, all voted aye.

County Sheriff, Doug Bass, informed the Board that his office seized twenty-eight horses south of Glidden due to neglect. Some of the horses went to the Animal Rescue League of Des Moines and eight stallions are being cared for by local veterinarians. Carroll County will be responsible for paying the feed and vet bills, which are expected to be substantial. The sheriff said he hopes to recoup some of the expense from the owner of the horses.

Motion by Meiners, second by Trobak to approve the Family Farm Tax Credit applications. On roll call, all voted aye.

The Board received the initial contract proposal from the Paramedics' Union.

Board reviewed a manure management annual update for Ivan Halbur, in Section 15 of Washington Township.

Motion by Trobak, second by Nieland to approve signing the payment voucher for a CDBG draw in the amount of \$3110, with \$1501 going to New Opportunities, and \$1609 going to Region XII. On roll call, all voted aye.

Meiners reported on Chamber presentation for board members and Y.E.S. Center.

Nieland reported on the Conservation Board meeting and Mt. Carmel project.

Danzer reported on WESCO, Solid Waste meeting, Ambulance Board meeting, and Planning & Zoning.

Motion by Meiners, second by Trobak to adjourn at 9:45 a.m. On roll call, all voted aye.
